- Considering any environmental issues within a particular project prior to tender stage.
- Design, operate and maintain all plant and equipment to the highest practicable standard and improve working practices as technology becomes available.
- Minimise waste throughout the company and on work sites. Aim for waste free processes wherever possible through better utilisation of raw materials, energy and water, increased use of renewable, reusable or recyclable materials.
- Developing relationships with suppliers and interested parties so that we all recognise our environmental responsibilities.
- Deal only with reputable, registered waste carriers for removal and disposal of waste unavoidably generated by our works.
- Educating staff so that Brooksby ensures that all its employees are aware of the potential environmental effects of their activities on all work sites by the following procedures:
- Provide Staff and site operative relevant environmental training to raise their awareness of minimizing waste, spill control methods and other specific site related environmental issues.
